In 1989, Dr. Rappaport founded TSR Technologies, Inc., a cellular radio/PCS software radio manufacturer that he sold in 1993. In 1995, he founded Wireless Valley Communications Inc., a pioneering creator of site-specific radio propagation software for network design and management that was acquired by Motorola, Inc. in 2005.

Regarding his appointment to the Paratek Advisory Board, Rappaport remarked, “Paratek is successfully tackling the issue of RF tuning. I’m thrilled to have the opportunity to contribute my experience to the development of technologies and products that will make next-generation wireless handsets perform better than ever.”
